I remind you that we are not here for a vacation, to sight see, or even to get a sun tan. We are here to win souls and that is all.

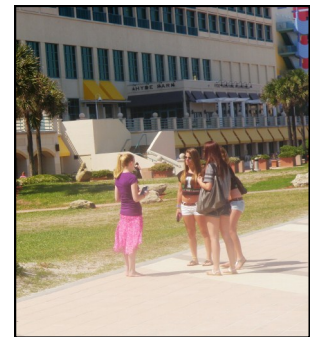
Let's go forth today in God's power, God's grace, God's strength, God's leadership, as we spread forth God's Word, especially the gospel message. JESUS SAVES!
